- Title: “**Siemens – Hellschreiber / Marconi**”
- Internal memo of Telefunken Ges.f.drahtl.Telegraphie m.b.H. (TFK), 21 May 1935, 1 page.
- TFK has no license or usage rights regarding the Hellschreiber patents. So, TFK is not in a position to grant license or rights to Marconi. TFK only has the exclusive distribution rights regarding Siemens-Hellschreibers in connection with wireless systems. However, there is no reason why Siemens could not enter into agreements regarding production and distribution rights within Marconi’s exclusive territory of the Telefunken-Marconi contract. However, outside this territory, Siemens can only make arrangements with the permission of Telefunken [FD: TFK was a Siemens – AEG joint venture, dating back to 1903]. E.g., if Marconi needs a number of Hellschreiber printers for a wireless installation in the Balkans, then Marconi must get this permission from Siemens via Telefunken, or Telefunken must be paid by Siemens for the deliveries.
