Nordeuropas bedste telefunkstation.

Sender: Bernhard - Be 10. Sendte som en Morsesender.

Antenne 27 meter høj og 34 meter bred. Roterede én gang/minut.

VHF-udstyr FuSAn724/725. Frekvens 30,0 – 31,1 Mhz. FuSAn724 var på 500 Watt. Rækkevidde 400 km.

Modtager: Bernhardine – Fug 120 Størrelse: 60x30x20 cm. Installeret i fly fra oktober 1944. Udskrift 10 sek. Pause 50 sek.

Streginddeling, der angav retning til senderen. Eks. 25 OR 14 12. Betød: Højde 2500 m, Position Oksbøl, Kurs 140 grader, 12 fjendtlige fly.

11. Ln.Fls.Peil-Komp. (t.Mot.) Klitmøller og Fernfunkfeuer Bernhard 10 Hundborg var pr. 01.10.1944 direkte underlagt IV/Ln-Rgt. Reich.

Carsten Petersen. Luftkrig over Danmark III side 84:

I løbet af 1944 var en række Bernhard-stationer blevet oprettet eller omstillet til natjageroperationer.

En af disse var Be 10 ved Hundborg i Thy.

I løbet af oktober 1944 blev natjagerbesætningerne på Karup kaldt sammen og gennemgik lektioner i Bernhard-Anlage.

Enheden, der bemandede stillingerne i "Kreuzotter", "Peildorf Klitmøller" og Bernhard anlægget i Hundborg, var i maj 1945 2./Ln. Flugsich. Rgt. Reich.

På det tidspunkt var der i stillingerne i "Kreuzotter" stationeret 3 underofficerer og 7 menige, i "Peildorf Klitmøller" 2 underofficerer og 2 menige, så

der har kun været tale om vagtmandskab. 2./Ln. Flugsich. Rgt. Reich Gr. Führer var stationeret i Thisted og var på samme tidspunkt bemanded med 1 officer, 8 underofficerer, 5 menige og 19 kontordamer.

I Stärkemeldung des Lw.-Bezirks III (Thisted) dateret maj 1945 benævnes enheden "Bernhard Anlage d.2./Ln. Flugsich. Rgt. Reich", og der var i stillingen stationeret 1 officer, 11 underofficerer, 5 menige og 17 kontordamer (Helferinnen), i alt 34 personer.

REGISTRATION THISTED COUNTY 2.

Description of areas outside HANSTHOLM.

Performed in 1945 by the Army Building Service 3rd Building District.

Done at December 1945 on the basis of optical distance measurement. Poul Boe, Land Inspector.

Data according to Morten Binnerup:

Northern Europe's best radio station.

Transmitter: Bernhard - Be 10. Transmitted like a Morse transmitter. Antenna 27 meters high and 34 meters wide. Rotated once / minute. VHF equipment FuSan724 / 725. Frequency 30.0 - 31.1 Mhz. FuSan724 was at 500 Watts. Range 400 km.

Receiver: Bernhardine - FuG 120. Size: 60x30x20 cm. Installed in aircraft starting October 1944. Printout 10 sec. Pause 50 sec.

Line division indicating the direction of the transmitter. E.g., "25 OR 14 12". Meaning: Elevation 2500 m, Position Oksbøl, Course 140 degrees, 12 enemy aircraft.

Iflg. Jørn Junker:

11. Ln.Fls.Peil-Companie (t. Mot.) at Klitmøller and radio beacon Bernhard 10 at Hundborg were per 01.10.1944 directly subject to IV / Luftnachrichten Regiment. Reich.

Carsten Petersen, Air War over Denmark III page 84:

During 1944, a number of Bernhard stations had been set up or converted into night fighter operations. One of these was Be 10 at Hundborg in Thy. During October 1944, the night fighter crews on Karup were called together and went through lessons in Bernhard-Anlage.

The unit that manned the positions in "Kreuzotter", "Peildorf Klitmøller" and the Bernhard plant in Hundborg in May 1945 was 2. Luftnachrichten Fast. Regiment. Reich. At that time, there were 3 non-commissioned officers and 7 privates stationed at the positions in "Kreuzotter"; in "Peildorf Klitmøller" 2 non-commissioned officers and 2 privates, so there has only been guard duty.

The Guppenführer of the 2. Luftnachrichten Fast. Rgt. Reich was stationed in Thisted and was at the same time staffed with 1 officer, 8 non-commissioned officers, 5 privates and 19 office ladies.

In a staffing strength report of the Lw.-Bezirks III (Thisted) dated May 1945, the unit is called "Bernhard Anlage der 2. Luftnachrichten Flugsicherungs Regiment. Reich". At the position were stationed 1 officer, 11 non-commissioned officers, 5 privates and 17 office ladies ("Helferinnen"), a total of 34 people.
