It developed a fault during transmission this morning so I would like it repaired and adjusted. Please tell Smee the repairs are urgent and arrange to send it back by Crawley in the Air Bag. Meanwhile I have made the original one function.

The cost you can refer to me in the usual manner.

Would you also ask Smee to let me have a new metal insert for the inking pad. The only one we have seems to worn slightly and is a very loose fit on the spindle. On occasions the roller will run off onto the floor so we have to watch the machine.

We can probably do something here to make the insert a tight fit but in view of the very slight cost it would be well worth while to have a spare.
